1 Research Field: American Society & Economy (U.S. Economy as Area Studies, Contemporary American History, or Contemporary American Studies as Social Sciences)

## 2 Responsibilities:

- (1) Teach required Social Studies courses such as Introduction to American Society, Research Case Studies Lecture (American Society & Economy), Research Readings I/II (American Society), Research Seminar (American Society); Basic Seminar; and Graduation Thesis in the Department of British and American Studies
- (2) Teach Graduate School courses (day-time / night-time)
- (3) Teach, British and American Studies language courses, School of Foreign Studies common courses, and University common courses (including English for non-English majors)
