Aichi Prefectural University invites applications for one full-time tenured teaching position, beginning April 1, 2021.

- 1 Research Field: English Linguistics (Semantics or Pragmatics)
- 2 Responsibilities:
 - (1) Teach required English Linguistics courses such as Introduction to English Linguistics & Philology, Research Case Studies Lecture (Features of Present-Day English Language), Research Case Studies Lecture (English Linguistics Research), Research Readings (English Linguistics & Philology), Research Seminar (English Linguistics & Philology); Basic Seminar; and Graduation Thesis in the Department of British and American Studies
 - (2) Teach Graduate School courses (day-time / evening-time)
 - (3) Teach British and American Studies language courses (Communicative English, Grammar & Basic Writing, Academic Writing, Research & Discussion, etc.), School of Foreign Studies common courses, and University common courses (including English for non-English majors)
