Announcement of Job Opening Fixed-term Full-time Teaching Positions in English Liberal Education Center, Aichi Prefectural University

Aichi Prefectural University invites applications for 4 fixed-term full-time non-tenured English teaching positions, beginning April 1, 2022.

Number of positions: 4

Responsibilities:

- (1) teach approximately ten 90-minute English classes per week. They include:
 (i) English for non-English-majoring students (English for Academic Studies, English for Interaction, Intercultural Seminars in English, etc.) and (ii) Liberal Education Subjects (Global Vision Talks, Japan Seen from Outside, etc.)
- (2) engage in language learning support programs
- (3) participate in teaching materials development and other activities related to English education
- (4) participate in Liberal Education Center related meetings and faculty development activities
- (5) engage in other duties assigned by the Director of the Liberal Education Center

Title: Professor (*Kyoju*) or Associate Professor (*Jun Kyoju*) or Lecturer (*Koshi*) (commensurate with qualifications and experience)

Job type: Fixed-term, full-time

Qualifications:

- (1) native or near native speaker of English
- (2) minimum of a master's degree or equivalent
- (3) minimum of 2 years of experience in teaching English as a second or foreign language (preferably at the university level) OR successful completion of a TESOL course with teaching experience
- (4) preferably have research publications (books, articles, etc.), but this is not a requirement
- (5) after appointment, must reside near Nagakute Campus located in Nagakute City, Aichi Prefecture
- Contract: The initial term of employment is from April 1, 2022 until March 31, 2023. Renewable annually by mutual agreement depending on working regulations until March 31, 2025.

Contract renewal will be decided based on the employee's work performance.

Salary: Annual salary (paid in monthly payments) is fixed as follows: Professor Approximately ¥7,500,000

Associate Professor	Approximately ¥7,000,000
Lecturer	Approximately ¥6,500,000

*There will be no periodic salary increases.

*Salary may change in case of a salary revision.

*Retirement allowance will not be granted.

- *An allowance for commuting expenses will be provided in accordance with the regulations of Aichi Prefectural University.
- *Relocation allowance (within Japan) will be provided in accordance with the regulations of Aichi Prefectural University. Overseas relocation allowance is not provided.

*Enrollment in social insurance will be required.

Housing: On-campus apartments may be available for rent if there is vacancy.

*Employees are expected to work on campus for 7 hours 45 minutes every workday (38 hours 45 minutes per week).

Selection process: After the screening of the application documents, short-listed applicants will be interviewed. Those residing in Japan will be asked to come to Aichi Prefectural University for on-campus interviews, including a teaching demonstration. Travel expenses must be paid by the applicants. For applicants residing overseas, interviews will be done online. After the selection process is over, the results will be sent by post to all the applicants.
