Full-time Position in the Department of British and American Studies, Beginning April 2025

Aichi Prefectural University invites applications for one full-time tenured teaching position, beginning April 1, 2025.

- 1 Research Field: Modern British History or History of the Commonwealth of Nations
- 2 Responsibilities:
 - (1) Teach required British History courses such as Introduction to British Society, Lecture (British History), Lecture (Cultural Exchanges in British History), Research Readings (British Society), Research Seminar (British Society); Basic Seminar; and Graduation Thesis in the Department of British and American Studies
 - (2) Teach Graduate School courses (day-time / evening-time)
 - (3) Teach British and American Studies language courses, School of Foreign Studies common courses, and University common courses (including English for non-English majors)
 - (4) Teach a total of 5 classes per week
 - *In addition to teaching, carry out duties related to university administration
- 3 Position: Lecturer or Associate Professor (commensurate with qualifications and experience)
- 4 Number of positions: 1
- 5 Type of position: full-time tenured (no term limit)
- 6 Qualifications:
 - (1) A Ph. D. degree or equivalent research achievements
 - (2) A high level of Japanese proficiency, sufficient to carry out duties in Japanese, if a non-native speaker of Japanese
 - (3) After appointment, must reside in or near Aichi Prefecture so as to be able to commute to the University (Nagakute Campus)
- 7 Starting date: April 1, 2025
- 8 Application deadline: June 14, 2024 (Application documents must be received by this date.)
- 9 Date of notification: The successful applicant will be notified around early October of 2024.
- 10 Application documents:
 - (1) A copy of curriculum vitae, in Japanese (according to the attached sheet: Format 1)
 - (2) A complete list of research publications and presentations (according to the attached sheet: Format 2)
 - (3) Three major research publications (submit three copies of each publication)

- *Publications in English should be accompanied by Japanese abstracts of around 600 characters, while publications in Japanese should be accompanied by English abstracts of around 500 words
- (4) A copy of the highest degree earned, or other proof of the highest educational attainment (documents in languages other than English or Japanese should be accompanied by a Japanese translation)
- (5) A list containing the names, phone numbers and e-mail addresses of two professional referees
- (6) Documents to prove his/her Japanese proficiency, such as articles written in Japanese, a certificate from the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, etc., if the applicant is a non-native speaker of Japanese
- (7) One stamped (110 yen for domestic mail) self-addressed return envelope (120×235mm) for notification of the result

(1) During the screening process, the selection committee may contact applicants by telephone or email and may ask them to come to Aichi Prefectural University for on-campus interviews and trial lessons (the interview and trial lessons may be conducted on-line, as the case may be).
