2 Qualifications:

- (1) Proficiency in Portuguese with full command of the language (It is desirable to also have basic Japanese communication skills.)
- (2) Minimum of a master's degree or equivalent
- (3) Extensive experience in teaching Portuguese as a second or foreign language OR research achievements about the Portuguese language with teaching experience
- (4) It is desirable to have experience as an examiner of Certificado de Proficiência em Língua Portuguesa para Estrangeiros (Celpe-Bras).
- (5) After appointment, must reside near the university

3 Responsibilities:

- (1) Position: Lecturer, or Associate Professor
- (2) Teaching Hours: nine 90-minute classes per week
- (3) Duties and Responsibilities: Teach required Iberian and Latin American Studies courses such as Portuguese Conversation and Writing, Portuguese Pronunciation and Listening Comprehension, Practical Portuguese (Research and Capstone Project), Academic Writing in Portuguese, Academic Presentation in Portuguese, Lecture (Lusophone Studies), Readings in Portuguese (Community), Readings in Portuguese (Global Issues), etc. AND participate in educational activities in the School of Foreign Studies and the Division.
- (4) Contract: The initial term of employment is one year from April 1, 2026 until March 31, 2027, and can be renewed annually for up to two years, by mutual agreement depending on the employment rules, until March 31, 2029. After the first three years, however, with the consent of both parties, further annual contract renewals will be possible, until March 31, 2032. The contract renewal of each year will be decided based on the employee's work performance.
- (5) În accordance with university guidelines, airfare expenses to Japan will be reimbursed for you (and your spouse) after your arrival from abroad.
